The readings this Sunday dwell on a favourite topic of Scripture, that Jesus is the light of the world. I find myself thinking of the Creed, where we acclaim the Second Person of the Trinity (the Word of God) as Light from Light and through whom all things were made. Then we can reflect on Genesis, where God creates through words i.e. the Word; and where first to be created is – light; and this light is before the sun and moon are created. All of which means that to properly begin to understand the universe we need to take, not the materialistic approach of science (though that has its uses certainly), but the path of wisdom, whereby we grasp that creation is a manifestation of the Word, though a pale reflection, just as created light is a pale reflection of uncreated Light from Light.
