THE BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST [A] 26th JUNE 2011

My dear friends

We come together on the Feast of Corpus Christi or by its other title, the Body and Blood of the Lord. This feast follows that of the Blessed Trinity for, through the Eucharist, they share with us their divine life. In the past, Corpus Christi has been celebrated on a Thursday recalling Holy Thursday, when Our Lord gave the mysteries of his body and blood for his disciples to celebrate. The disciples, that is, of every time and place.

"The Eucharist is the source and summit of the Church's life". [Vatican II]. Soon we will be using the new translation of the Roman Missal which will enhance our celebration of Mass. You will have heard the letter from all the Bishops [copies still available] and our own Bishop will write to us again in September when we start to use the new responses. Next weekend we will show you a copy of these responses and Fr Neil and I will use the homily to speak about it.

I will end with the very succinct explanation of the Eucharist by St Thomas Aquinas in his verse "O Sacrum Convivium": *O sacred banquet in which Christ is received, the memory of his passion is recalled, our minds are filled with grace, and a pledge of future glory is given to us.*
