We would love to know what they spoke about, no doubt St Peter sharing all his personal experiences and St Paul describing his vocation to bring the Gospel to the Gentiles.

They had animated discussions at the Council of Jerusalem, the first Council of the Church, when it was decided that converts from other nations did not need to observe Jewish customs. In the preface of the Mass we hear the words : "Each in a different way gathered together the one family of Christ: and revered together

throughout the world, they share one Martyr's Crown".
