Our Bishop Thomas writes:

The Olympic Games have obviously had a unique place in the life of our country this summer and the same is equally true for our Diocese. I have twice visited Stratford - the host parish for the Olympic Park - for special Masses: one during the Games themselves and a delightful Parish occasion on the day of their closing. I also visited St Bonaventure's where the Joshua Camp was based. This was a group of young people from all over Europe whose role was to visit the Games venues to both support and evangelise those attending. These spiritual aspects to the Games have been a vital part of the overall celebration. So I would like to offer special thanks to Mgr John Armitage and to Mr James Parker who have worked selflessly and generously over the last three years. Also to the Friars and Parish Community in Stratford for the indispensable part they played. Chaplaincy was generously provided and we thank all our Diocesan priests who took on this role. Hospitality formed a very special part of the Games and we are particularly grateful to the Ursulines and to St Anthony's Forest Gate for generously receiving people in this way. There was also great preparation with Schools in Newham Deanery. I would also like to recognise with gratitude the constant Prayer and Adoration throughout the Games and for the close working with other Churches and Faiths, all of which contributed to the spirit and success of the Games as a whole.
