The fourth Sunday of Lent is Laetare Sunday. This is Latin of the first word of the entrance Antiphon 'Rejoice Jerusalem.' For the first time since Ash Wednesday Flowers briefly return, more joyful music can be heard and Rose (not pink) vestments are worn. On this day, we pause momentarily to revel in the ultimate victory that is to come. While it's not yet the white of Easter, Rose displays something of the Easter joy spilling out for us to taste as we journey on. For centuries on this day, the Pope would confer a sacred rose ornament of pure gold on Churches and individuals to honour their catholic spirit and loyalty to the Holy see. Now, it is often given to various Marian Shrines in honour of our Lady, which seems very fitting for Mother's day. Like the prodigal son in today's gospel no matter how far we may feel that we have gone from home through our sin Holy Mother Church waits to confer on us the rose of forgiveness and the sweet balm of mercy, in the sacrament of confession. When though a good examination of conscience we come to ourselves and realise our sin and sorrow Holy Mother Church will lead us through this sacrament on the golden road back to the Fathers heart. Filled with expectant hope, we rejoice!
