SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER (G) (Divine Mercy Sunday) Week Commencing 27th April 2025

Today is now known as Divine Mercy Sunday, a very appropriate title given the scripture readings. In the Gospel it is easy to focus on Doubting Thomas and miss much else. The greeting of Jesus, repeated, is, 'Peace be with you'. Isn't peace something many people yearn for but do not find? What prevents us? Surely the opening words of Jesus are linked with what comes next, the forgiveness of sins. The two go together, if we wish to have true peace then we need to ask for and receive forgiveness. Many who describe themselves as Catholics have abandoned the practice of going to Confession (Reconciliation is a better word), they also often fail to teach their children about the Sacrament. I should say that the number who regularly go to Confession in this parish is much better than other parishes I have been in, though it could still improve. One final comment. The synoptic Gospels take the approach of showing a man who is also God. St. John instead shows a God who is also man.
