In today's second reading, St. Paul poses some rhetorical questions. Who could ever be God's counsellor? Given that God is all-wise and all-knowing, the answer should be obvious, no-one. Quite clear and straightforward we would think, yet in practice it's not so simple. I'm thinking here of the prayers people make. Is it not true that people very often ask God to do things in a way which is 'counselling God'? The petitioner has already worked out the 'right' way in which God should act, the prayer is then a matter of asking God to get on with it. It's not uncommon to meet people who have given up on God precisely because their prayers weren't answered, meaning that God didn't jump to attention and carry out the person's will. Prayer is time spent listening to God, seeking his will, his counsel.
