My Dear friends

We continue to journey through these joyful days of the Easter season. On Wednesday this week, we begin the month of May, dedicated to the Mother of God. In a special way, Mary the Mother of the Church, will be united with us as we journey through the days of our Lord's Ascension, the coming of the Spirit at Pentecost and the celebration of the Blessed Trinity.

On two Sunday's in May (19th and 26th) we will have our First Holy Communion celebrations. Let us pray for our children as they make their final preparations for this day and commend them also to the prayers of Our Lady.

On Friday 3rd May, we will celebrate the feast of our parish patron, St James the Less – who shares his day with St Philip, as both apostles are buried together in the church of the Twelve Apostles in Rome. Masses are at 9:15am and 6:30pm and our minds go back to the Mass of Thanksgiving that we had on that day last year to mark our 175th anniversary. St James the Less as he is called, to differentiate him from St James the Great, the son of Zebedee – was a cousin of the Lord. The first leader of the church in Jerusalem, where he was martyred in the year 62AD. He, like all the apostles, fulfilled the Lord's command in today's Gospel to love as he has loved us, in laying down his life for the faith.

During Easter, we sing the Regina Caeli in honour of Mary, the mother of the Risen Lord
