My dear friends

Next weekend we will begin to use the new translation to the Roman Missal. From September to the first Sunday of Advent, November 27th, we will concentrate upon the peoples' responses at Mass. There will be cards on the pews for you to follow. You will notice that every time the priest says "The Lord be with you" you will respond with "And with your spirit."

Readers please note that you conclude the reading with the simple phrase: "The word of the Lord." We will use the new "I confess", Gloria and Creed. After the Consecration the priest simply says "The mystery of faith" to which we respond with one of the three new Acclamations.

Until we get the new Mass books in Advent you will have to listen to the new Prefaces and Eucharistic prayers. The readings remain the same for the time being.

This will be very new for all of us, priests and people, and I am sure that we will come to love the new prayers in the fullness of time.
