As Catholics we ought to be familiar with the call of Jesus to be humble. Historically, many people have shied away from humility, seeing it as weakness, instead preferring ostentatious pride by striving to appear great in other peoples' eyes. The word itself has its roots, we could say, in the Latin for soil, humus. I think here of the parable of the sower, where the seed, the word of God, is fruitful only when it falls into rich soil, humus. Gardeners will appreciate the general usefulness of a good humus, if they hope for healthy plants. Humility isn't a matter of becoming a doormat for others, it requires work to 'till the soil, enrich it' which in terms of a human being would entail cultivating the virtues, controlling one's passions, seeking after truth, praying. In those and other ways, an individual is able to receive graces from God such that they are indeed fruitful, the grace multiplying in the rich humus while weeding out undesirable habits.
