THE FOURTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR [B] January 29th 2012

My dear friends

I was glad to arrive home safely from my holiday last Sunday night, considering the terrible fate of those who died in the Costa Concordia tragedy. We pray that all those who have died recently will come to the safe harbour of eternal life.

The Octave of Prayer for Christian Unity concluded on Thursday with the feast of the Conversion of St Paul. It is unique to celebrate the feast of someone's conversion, but Paul's mission to spearhead the Church's missionary expansion was of great importance. He describes that conversion in Acts, Chapter 9 and in Galatians, Chapter 1. The following day is the feast of Ss. Timothy and Titus, Paul's closest collaborators. He writes these encouraging words to Timothy in a pastoral letter to him:-

"That is why I am reminding you now to fan into a flame the gift that God gave you when I laid my hands on you. God's gift was not a spirit of timidity, but the Spirit of power, and love and self control. So you are never to be ashamed of witnessing to the Lord, or ashamed of me for being his prisoner; but with me, bear the hardships for the sake of the Good News, relying on the power of God who has saved us and called us to be holy." 1Tim;1

This Thursday is the feast of Our Lord's Presentation in the Temple when Simeon recognises Jesus as the Light of the World. We assemble with lighted candles on that day, Candlemas, to pray that the Lord will come into this temple, that is, our parish church in this its 175th year. Mass is at 9:15am.
