### PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD [B]

My dear friends

On this Palm Sunday we begin the solemn celebration of Holy Week and follow Jesus through the events of his Passion. Death and Resurrection.

On Monday we have Mass at 7:30am and 9:15am. At 7:30pm, all three priests will be available for the Sacrament of Reconciliation.

Tuesday, Mass at 9:15am Priory St and 11:00am at Monkwick with an opportunity for confession.

Wednesday - Masses are at 7:30am, 12:15pm and 10:00am Mass at Mersea with confessions. In the evening at 7:00pm, there is the Chrism Mass at Brentwood Cathedral to which everyone is welcome: The Bishop blesses the Holy Oils to be used during the year and all the priests of the diocese renew their priestly commitment.

Maundy Thursday - there is the Mass of the Last Supper in the evening at 8pm. We remember the Institution of the Eucharist and re-enact the Washing of the Feet. At the end of the Mass we can watch at the Altar of Repose until Midnight, recalling Jesus' Agony in the Garden.

Good Friday - 10am Stations of the Cross at Mile End, 10:30am Children's Stations at Priory St. At 11:45am – 12 noon we assemble with fellow Christians at the Salvation Army Citadel, Butt Road, for our Walk of Witness to the War Memorial - where there will be a short service. 3pm is the Celebration of the Lord's Passion and Stations of the Cross at 7:30pm.
