FOURTH SUNDAY OF EASTER [B] April 29th 2012

Today, the fourth Sunday of Easter, Good Shepherd Sunday, is the day chosen as the World Day of Prayer for Vocations to the Priesthood and Consecrated Life. Pope Benedict has written to us this year on the theme "Vocations, the Gift of the Love of God". He hopes that local communities will become places where vocations are carefully discerned and their authenticity tested, places where young men and women are offered wise and strong spiritual direction.' That is a challenging vision for parishes to achieve but as the Holy Father points out 'In this way, the Christian community itself becomes a manifestation of the love of God in which every calling is contained.'

Anyone considering Priesthood is warmly invited to contact Fr Dominic Howarth, Diocesan Vocations Director. This year three students will begin in seminary at Valladolid in September: Brenden Thompson, Ian Yardley and David Peace. Our prayers are asked for them and for existing seminarians Eamonn Hyde, Gary Dench, Patrick Daly and David Pearce, as well as Nick de Keyser and Matthew Bemand. Nick and Matthew will be ordained Deacons in June and Priests in October. For young men and women aged 18 – 30 and wanting a place to reflect, pray and chat about vocation, you are very welcome to the new **Brentwood Vocations Discernment Group.** Meeting monthly, an evening together includes a meal, a talk by a Priest or Religious sharing their vocational journey, a time of quiet prayer and a chance to ask questions both in a group and one to one.
