What image comes to mind when we hear the words, 'I am the vine, you are the branches'? Many people seem to think of a vine stock (Jesus) from which come branches (us), an image which surely is not correct. Repeatedly in the Gospel passage we have the word, 'in' so that we are called to remain in Jesus. He is the whole vine, stock and branches; we are part, the branches. The Holy Spirit is the sap, one might say, which flows throughout the whole plant. Through faith we are grafted on to the vine, become a branch, such that the Spirit gives life to our actions and we can bear fruit. The biggest obstacle to this life-giving situation is our attachment to self, expressed by the word, 'I'. We might usefully consider how frequently in an average day we use the word, 'I', especially in comparison with the occasions we consciously seek to enact God's will.
