## WEEK COMMENCING 29TH MAY 2022

The first reading this Sunday relates the culmination of the encounter of Stephen with the Jewish authorities. It could be seen as an example of prejudice (the people block their ears and shout out so as not to hear what he is saying) resulting in mob violence in which Stephen is murdered. Although that would be true, it's not how it comes across. I find that the passage radiates serenity and joy. Stephen throughout is serene, peaceful, rejoicing in wonder at what he is seeing. He doesn't fight or even defend himself, rather he imitates Christ on the Cross, accepting his persecution, entrusting himself to God and praying for his attackers (a clear parallel with what Jesus says). The Church in this account is also joyful, not critical or judgmental. Stephen, as a word, means 'crown'; the church is confident that he is in heaven, crowned with glory. We see in the world around us so much anger and violence, let's not add to that but instead imitate St. Stephen, and thereby of course Jesus himself, and so win crowns for ourselves. Fr. Chris
