This Sunday the Gospel is taken from John 6, and for five weeks we stay with that chapter. St. John's Gospel differs from the other three in not describing the institution of the Eucharist at the Last Supper, instead he presents it in chapter 6. Jesus multiplies loaves and this is followed by quite a lengthy dialogue in which Jesus gives us a wonderful teaching on the real presence. I'm anticipating some of the later verses but they can help us with the present passage, as the chapter forms a cohesive whole. The vocabulary Jesus will use is striking and leads to the bewilderment of the Jews since they correctly understand the words but can't cope with the implications. The multiplication of the loaves points back to the manna in the desert and points forward to the true bread from heaven, Jesus himself in the Eucharist.
