Family life is experiencing a crisis of stability, partly caused by economic hardship, but often by other factors like lack of generosity, or too much insistence on getting one's own way. Today's feast invites us to meditate on our own contribution to family life. In the homespun maxims of Ben Sirach, we read how Jewish families in Our Lord's time applied the Fourth Commandment as a promise of blessing Sir 3:3-7, 14-17. A practical application of the fourth commandment, that we should honour our parents, not only when we are young, but also when they are old and in need of care.

Finally, the Gospel story of the flight into Egypt shows how even Jesus, Mary and Joseph, that best of all families, had to cope with dangers and hardships, which they faced together with the help of God.
