LIVERPOOL CARE PATHWAY REVIEW. Several senior doctors have publicly criticised the use of the Pathway, asserting that it can mean hastening death for vulnerable patients. A number of families have spoken out in the media about the abuses their loved ones have suffered as a result of being put on the Liverpool Care Pathway in hospitals and nursing homes. The Government is holding a review and the deadline for responses is Friday April 5th. The review panel includes leading proeuthanasia advocates so it is very important that the opposition of Catholics is voiced clearly, especially those with personal experience.
