Today's Gospel includes one of the most famous parables of Jesus. It is commonly known as, 'The Prodigal Son' though that title itself raises questions. Why not, 'The Forgiving Father' (sometimes used) or, 'The Unforgiving Brother'? The parable is full of all sorts of details on which it is fruitful to meditate. Yet there is one short phrase which is often overlooked despite its importance in understanding the principal thrust of the story. Think for a moment yourself, which phrase would you give prominence? I would suggest the opening five words, 'A man had two sons', Jesus is emphasising the key relationship which we need to be aware of, that we are sons and daughters of God our Father. As it happens, neither of the two sons truly appreciate this, even the prodigal if you consider the text carefully.
