<u>EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR</u> July 31st 2011

My dear friends,

My Jesus, I believe that you are present in the most Blessed Sacrament. I love You above all things and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot now receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You have already come, and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen. (St Aphonsus Ligouri).

Blessed John Paul II in tells us that we should "*cultivate in our hearts a constant desire for the sacrament of the Eucharist.* This was the origin of the practice of 'Spiritual Communion', which has happily been established in the Church for centuries and recommended by saints who were masters of the spiritual life". (*Ecclesia de Eucharistia* #34)

St. Thomas Aquinas calls a Spiritual Communion "an ardent desire to receive Jesus in the Most Holy Sacrament and lovingly embracing Him as if we had actually received Him." It is a source of grace and it helps us to keep in the presence of Christ throughout the day. Why not call in to church during the week and make a Spiritual Communion before the Blessed Sacrament?

There is a practical dimension too. For those who genuinely cannot get to Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation, it is a way of uniting ourselves to Christ and the Church. (But if we've just decided to go to the garden centre instead of Mass, it won't do)! If we have a mortal sin on our conscience, and so are unable to receive Holy Communion until we get to Confession, or if we have broken the 1-hour Eucharistic fast, then a Spiritual Communion is an excellent way of telling God that we want to be united with Him.
