All is vanity, says the Preacher; a very comprehensive statement. He's considering the world about us, noting how everything changes and decays, and a person's time here is all too brief. The psalm has some good advice along the same lines, 'Make us know the shortness of our life that we may gain wisdom of heart'. True wisdom is very different from being clever or knowledgeable, it is concerned with what is eternal, something developed in the second reading where St. Paul rightly calls us to focus on Christ. Finally, Jesus in the Gospel addresses the same question and encourages us to become rich in the sight of God. A wonderful harmony in the readings this week, a reminder not to become preoccupied with the world despite all that is beautiful and good in it. As St. Paul expresses it elsewhere, 'Our true home is in heaven' and we are exhorted to set our hearts there, not on the things of earth.
